2. Simulation: "Canadian Sports"

Name of the simulation	Canadian Sports
Sequence of the simulation	 The children are welcomed by one of the players and get their tickets for the lacrosse/hockey game. The video is started inside of the sports hall. Children enter the sports hall while the national anthem of Canada is sung by the players. The children sit down. The children watch the video sequence which is commented by the players. Breaking news: The captain of the lacrosse/hockey team has been injured. The lacrosse/ hockey team captain enters the sports hall with crutches and a bandage around his knee. He tells the children that he was ill and that he needed the children to play in his position: "Hello my name is Marcus and I am the captain of the Canadian lacrosse/hockey team. As you have seen and heard in the video I have broken my leg (pointing at his leg). So I cannot play in the next game. Now we need a new captain for our lacrosse/hockey team. And YOU are now going to try to play some lacrosse/hockey. Would you like to try it out? Okay. We are going to divide you into two groups. The 1st group is going to practice with Nele and me. And the other half is going with Thomas and Florian to make some photos for an autograph card. After that we will switch the groups" The children train to play lacrosse/hockey. Afterwards, they are photographed in an original hockey equipment. In the end, the children and players come together again. The captain of the lacrosse/hockey team thanks the children for helping them.
